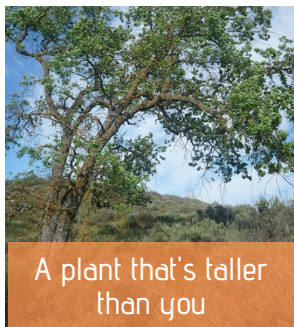

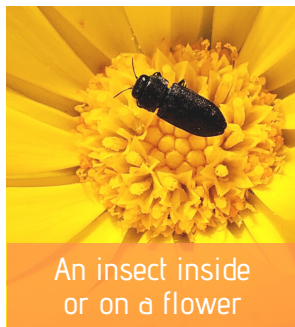

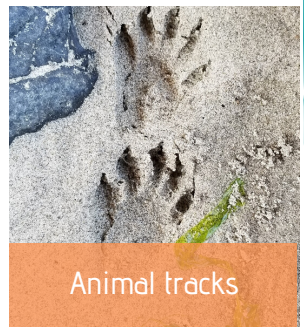

A lady beetle (lady bug)



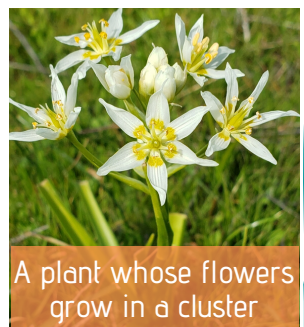
